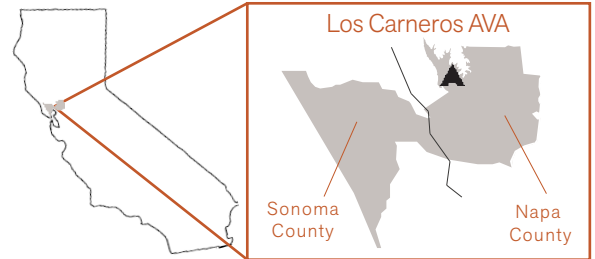


A CENTURIES-OLD WINEMAKING LEGACY PLANTS ROOTS IN NAPA

In 1991, Spain's oldest winemaking family, Raventós Codorníu, ventured to a new world: a sea-facing hillside in the Napa Valley, with rocky soils and a favorable coastal climate. It was here in Los Carneros, that we planted new roots, building upon a 500-year winemaking legacy to create the next generation of estate-grown, artisan wines. We named it Artesa.

VARIETAL: 100% Pinot Noir

VINTAGE: 2017



TERROIR:

Diverse terrain of rolling hills with variable topography, exposure and soil types, planted to eleven clones of pinot noir



WINEMAKING:

50% Native Yeast
50% Inoculated
Aged 10 months
French Oak (20% new)



AROMAS:

Beautiful, bright aromas of cherry, plum and a hint of rose petal



PALATE:

Classic, medium bodied and silky texture, lush flavors of strawberry, mulberry and blueberry, accentuated with spice and earth



PAIRING:

Vibrant, natural acidity makes this an excellent partner to many foods - goat cheese, beets, salmon, duck and lamb are all complementary
